**Callanwolde Fine Arts Center Hosts: Halloween Night on Callanwolde Mountain**

(Atlanta, GA, August. 25, 2014) Callanwolde Fine Arts Center, a nationally recognized historic venue, is hosting the first annual Halloween Night on Callanwolde Mountain. On October 31, Callanwolde celebrates Halloween for the whole family by filling the 12 acre historic estate with a live Halloween concert, door to door trick or treating, and LEGOLAND Halloween building activities. The Callanwolde Concert Band along with Atlanta Braves Organist, Matthew Kaminski, will be performing selections from *Night on Bald Mountain*, *Phantom of the Opera*, and *Pirates of the Caribbean*. Kids can trick or treat door to door through 18 different locations on the Callanwolde estate. Exciting prizes will be given for the best family-friendly Halloween costumes and for the most creative Bring Your Own Carved Pumpkins Contest. Kids can build with Halloween themed LEGOs, and Bertie, the LEGO mascot, will be coming by for meet and greet.

Matthew Kaminski, along with the Callanwolde Concert Band, will be filling the mansion with Halloween inspired selections on Callanwolde's Aeolian Organ, whose 3,742 pipes run all through the Callanwolde mansion. Take a break from trick or treating and listen to Storytellers spin spooky stories amid the historic gardens on the estate. Food trucks will be on hand as well as a cash bar to provide refreshment.

Halloween Night on Callanwolde Mountain will take place Friday, October 31 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. Tickets for the event are \$4 online and \$5 at the door and can be purchased at <http://callanwolde.org/>. Tickets go on sale September 15. Pumpkins for the contest must be carved and ready for display. Drop off for carved pumpkins is at 6:00pm. Parking is free and located onsite.
